MAINSTREAM JAZZ

We said we are an italian mainstream jazz label, but here we mean the Mainstream Jazz as a music without boundaries of the historical period. Something different from today's jazz that unfortunately has been too tainted by the new tendencies of northern Europe styles, that have totally lost the sense of swing, pulsation, "drive". We firmly believe that in those years the most beautiful pages of Jazz were written. Tosky Records loves to work with new talents and famous names of Italian and International Jazz scene.



JAZZ NEW EXPRESSION

Projects contained in this new collection are high-value projects with a plant based music definitely jazz but with far-reaching towards new sounds, more electric, more contemporary sometimes with use of samples and sound effects. A more experimental and contemporary line called New Expressions. We decided to start this editorial line to allow the publication of projects of high artistic content even if they have a very different connotation from the Mainstream Jazz line. So, our world is Jazz music but we love music and we understand today the value of influences, as well as Miles Davis was fascinated during his electrical period.



SOUND LIBRARIES (MUSIC)

Music Libraries have an important role in video synchronizations for cinema and TV shows. TV stations, operators, editors and directors can grab from this diversified-theme catalogue to match the perfect soundscapes for their jobs. Music Libraries start with titles "MUSIC FOR ..."



SOUND LIBRARIES (SFX)

Sound Libraries line is divided into a collection specialized in Sound Effects. We called them "Project Effects Libraries" recorded and managed internally in Avid ProTools at a sample rate of 192Khz and 24bit resolution with the possibility to choose through different microphones used to ensure the best quality and flexibility. These libraries are designed and recorded by Tosky Records. SFX Libraries start with titles "SOUNDS FOR ..." to differentiate from Music production titles (Sound Libraries Production Music).



JAZZ MAINSTREAM



He's one of the finest jazz italian pianists, a repertoire of original songs and selected standards, following the footsteps of illustrious visionaries such as Ahmad Jamal, George Shearing and Brad Mehldau. Without the slightest concession to the sterile virtuosity, is beautifully accompanied by two of the most representative musicians of their generation: Marco Valeri on drums, whose list of collaborations is already almost as long as that of his far more experienced partner, Giorgio Rosciglione double bass, famous protagonist of Italian jazz since the early 60's. An avant-garde classic.

Domenico Sanna, winner of the Jimmy Awards as best pianist Tuscia in Jazz 2008, prize Luca Flores 2009, has collaborations with national and international artists: Stefano Di Battista and Nicky Nicolai "Over the Sun" (Universal Music), Rick Margitza "One Special Night in Italy" (Tuscia in Jazz Records) with Flavio Boltro, Michel Rosciglione, Remi Vignolo and Francisco Mela, Jd Allen that cut "Too High" in the quintet Marco Acquarelli, Dave Liebman and again Steve Grossman, Roberto Gatto, Greg Hutchinson, Gege Munari, Dede Ceccarelli, Fabio Morgera, Daniele Tittarelli and many others. It has been called one of the most refined and interesting pianist of the moment. Marco Valeri, drummer and composer icon now for the new generations of musicians from Rome. He collaborated with Dado Moroni, Dave Liebman, Danilo Rea, Eddie Gomez, Kurt Rosenwinkel, George Garzone, Eddie Henderson, Steve Grossman, John Amato, Flavio Boltro. His list of collaborations is almost as long as that of his far more experienced partner, Giorgio Rosciglione double bass, famous protagonist of Italian jazz since the early 60's. He has recorded over 100 CDs and worked with the best italian and international jazz musicians, such as George Coleman, Louis Hayes, Tony Scott, Kenny Clark, Tooth Thielemans, Benny Golson, Kenny Barron, Mulgrew Miller, Joe Pass, Lee Konitz, Art Farmer, Freddy Hubbard, Bobby Durham and others.

If the current direction of blue notes can testify to both the past and future of jazz, the music of Marco Acquarelli's quintet lends aesthetic awareness and listening pleasure to an elegantly produced album to be considered as "historical feeling" and intention to put forward intelligent and sophisticated ideas, without ever falling in to dejà ecoute but rather creatively innovating an already extraordinarily composed repertoire. Its sense of the "contemporary", featuring fundamental and luminous arrangements and solos, bears witness to a wide-ranging artistic universe, a poetic glow of absolute and superb appeal.

This young and talented charismatic guitarist has collaborated with numerous other artists, including Maurizio Giammarco, Daniele Tittarelli, Claudio Corvini, Massimo Manzi and Sandro Deidda, to cite just a few. He alternates an intense learning path with live activity, perfecting his study with artists of such calibre as Jim Kelly, Bill Pierce, Peter Bernstein, Barry Harris, Agostino Di Giorgio, Adam Rogers, Mark Turner, Matt Renzi, Dominic Miller and Tuck Andress. In 2010, his first record project as a leading musician was released, "Too High", which included the participation of tenor saxophonist J.D. Allen. He has collaborated with various composers and directors in numerous projects for music for the theatre, television and film (Germano Mazzocchetti, Nicola Piovani, Lucio Gregoretti, Stefano Reali, the Orchestra of Rome, the Orchestra of the S. Cecilia Conservatory and the Orchestra of Roberto Pregadio). In the band, musicians of exceptionally high level already active for years in the Roman jazz scene. The splendid voice of Alice Ricciardi embellishes this record project, reminding us once again just how much Roman jazz is a source of pride all over the world.



The talent of two excellent musicians who work together to create something new: a repertoire of original and standard compositions. **Gianluca Lusi** worked with several famous artists: Danilo Rea, Maurizio Giammarco, Paolo Damiani, Massimo Moriconi, Massimo Manzi, Giovanni Amato, Riccardo Fassi, Pino Jodice, Giorgio Rosciglione, Gianluigi Goglia, Claudio Filippini, Bill Carrothers, Peter Epstein, Larry Panella, Darrian Douglas, Russell Welch, Andy Gravish, Heinrich Kobberling, Thomas Siffling, Pietro Iodice. He graduated at the Conservatories of Santa Cecilia di Roma and at the Casella dell'Aquila. He has done two albums: "Gotha 17" and "Rune". **Joel Holmes** studied at the School for the Performing Arts in Baltimora at first, then he took a degree in Jazz Performance at the John Hopkins University. He won several prizes as pianist and composer in the United States. He's a member of the quintet of Roy Hargrove since 2009 and he did tours in some of the most famous festivals and clubs of the world. He collaborated also with some stars of Jazz music such as Roberta Gambarini and Nnenna Freelon with whom he recorded an album nominated for a Grammy Award. Joel has done two albums which had a lot of success trough the critics: "Ethernal Vision" in a trio and "African Skies" as a quartet featuring the saxophonist Gary Thomas. He is now considered one of the best emerging pianist in the world.

The beautiful Villa d'Este in Tivoli, with its rooms, its fountains and gardens proves the perfect setting for a musical project 'for life'. Strike with wonder and anxiety notes the silent rooms of Moses and Noah coloring them with echoes of bebop and cool jazz, mysterious sounds that recall past glories, immaculate in all their beauty.

Debut trio album for the young bass player Dario Germani accompanied by excellent musicians: Stefano Preziosi on alto sax and Luigi Del Prete on drums, embellished by the soloist and the overwhelming personality of the prolific tenor saxophonist Max Ionata as guest. Is a clear need of the trio to create a bridge between the various periods. As evidence of this the choice of Villa D' Este (residence of the Hungarian composer Franz Liszt) as location for the recording session. From a strictly musical point of view it denotes a clear interest in the compositions of the period Bebop (Crepuscule with Nellie, Little Willie Leaps; Bud on Bach) to Cool Jazz (Late Lament) and the blues form of Yusef Lateef (For Life). The three original songs have different characteristics but share the same melodic originality-expressive while remaining in traditional forms. Born in 1984, he began to study electric bass at a very young age, trained under the tutelage of Maestro Gianluca Renzi, then he switched to double bass. He has always combined classic studies (Frosinone Conservatory) with Jazz improvisation and arrangement. He has attended the following Master Classes: 2005. Roma Jazz's Cool (G. Tommaso); 2006. Berklee Summer School at Umbria Jazz (D. Clark; C. Zanghieri); 2007. Tuscia in Jazz (B. Williams; G. Rosciglione); 2008. Nuoro Jazz (A. Zanchi; C. Brown); 2009. Siena Jazz (P. Dalla Porta; S. Colley; B. Allison; D. Gress); 2010. Capbreton (H.V. De Geyn; L. Grenadier); 2011. Orsara di Puglia (J. Webber); 2012. La Spezia (E. Gomez); 2012: He has been awarded the Lucky Award as Best Arranger (Orsara Jazz).

Noise in the box, a long and exciting journey full of sonorous surprises and stylistic influences in which compositions at the limit of musical genres represent a bridge that crosses the most extreme musically diverse territories. Complex architectural compositions alternate with moments of elegant minimalism, while prolonged moments of vibrant energy give way to reminiscent melodies without ever sacrificing the coherence of a musical discourse whose hallmarks are sounds, words and echoes of a lived musical life. All of this and more are all jammed pack into a little box.

It is the first album as band leader for the eclectic guitarist Luigi Masciari, an experienced performer who has numerous collaborations with renowned Italian artists including Danilo Rea and Paolo Damiani, an award-winning composer in the United States who honed his talents by learning from legendary musicians such as Billy Taylor, George Cables and Curtis Fuller, is the skillful director of this musical project which features special guest Francesco Bearzatti, one of the most active and creative saxophonists in jazz in Europe. Musical atmospheres clearly derived from rock mesh with songs centred on collective improvisation, while markedly blues pieces blend with reminiscences of a more traditional jazz. Unusual ways to accompanying characterize the rhythmic phrasing of Paternesi, who, in perfect harmony with the fluid bass lines designed extemporaneously by Mencarelli provides the necessary support to exceptional soloists such as Cristiano Arcelli - undisputed saxophone genius - and Enrico Zanisi - revelation of Italian jazz pianism, who demonstrates his expertise with the fender rhodes with absolute ease. Therefore, it is an ambitious musical project that tells a true story of "noisy" emotions as it shifts in and out of musical areas that are not always easy to label.

Marco Guidolotti, excellent saxophonist, won the international competition Massimo Urbani in 2010, he's a very active soloist in RAI, Mediaset and Sky. Here, he pays a tribute to the great music of Gerry Mulligan and especially to the quartet with the trumpeter Chet Baker. Golden years for West Coast Jazz music. An album full of joy and swing, that mix unreleased songs by Guidolotti and famous songs of the legendary Gerry Mulligan.

Born in Mantova, in 1977. Marco Guidolotti started saxophone education at 6 and got his degree in clarinet in 1999 at the "A. Casella Conservatory" in L' Aquila. He then specialized in saxophone with Gianni Oddi and Sandro Deidda. In 2010 he got a degree, cum laude, in "Jazz music" at Santa Cecilia Conservatory in Rome. He has been performing, as soloist, at Rai, Mediaset and Sky TV, soundtracks and audio-visual synch, with among others Ennio Morricone, Armando Trovajoli, Luis Bacalov, Stefano di Battista, Roberto Gatto, Enrico Pieranunzi and in an international setting with Woody Allen, Bob Brookmeyer, Dave Liebman, Randy Crawford, Dee Dee Bridgewater, Paul McAndless, Miroslav Vitous and others. Active in major musical events and theatrical tours with the Rome Sistina Theater and Parco della Musica, and Milan Arcimboldo, Marco has performed in theaters all over the world, Usa, Colombia, Canada, Turkey, Albania, Russia, Portugal with Italian and international music groups, and in several international jazz festivals: Montreal and Ottawa, Tunja and Medellin Jazz Festival, Tomar, Tirana, Istanbul, Ankara and Izmir, Minsk, Tabarka, Mons, New York with the saxophone ensemble "Ialsax Quartet", Antwerp, Gent, Bruges, Nyons and Nantes, Barranquilla, Bogota, Cali, XXII International Jazz Fest. In 2010 he was awarded by prestigious "International Massimo Urbani Award" reserved to saxophone players of his generation, from all over the world. "Never Fault Behind The Scenes" is a quartet project by Gianluca Lusi being involved in a totally original work alongside exceptional musicians. An album that ranges from modern mainstream to free jazz, with intense melodic cues, enhanced by the powerful rhythmic contribution of the two stars Reuben Rogers and Gregory Hutchinson. Album that represents the consecration of the italian saxophonist and his musical style.

Gianluca Lusi, multi-sax player and composer has worked with several international artists: Danilo Rea, Maurizio Giammarco, Bill Carrothers, Massimo Manzi, Giovanni Amato, Riccardo Fassi, Joel Holmes, Peter Epstein, Larry Panella, Andy Gravish, Olivier Hutman. Among some of his works: "Rune" (Splasch Records), the duo "Loose" alongside Joel Holmes (Tosky Records) and "What's New" (Caligola Records). Andrea Rea, pianist born in 1983, he collaborates with musicians such as Dado Moroni, Kenny Barron, Barry Harris, Maurizio Giammarco, Julian Oliver Mazzariello. He won: "Baronissi Jazz", "Tuscia in Jazz" and even "Piacenza Jazz" and "Jazz no Tea Factory". In 2007 he's the winner of the prestigious international award "Massimo Urbani". Reuben Rogers born in 1974, found his true passion in the bass; Rogers' musical education is punctuated by numerous outstanding student awards, most notably, a scholarship endowed by the Fish Middleton Jazz Society, he earned his Bachelor of Music in 1997 from Berklee College of Music. He has enjoyed with jazz artists of world-renown, such as Wynton Marsalis, Roy Hargrove, Joshua Redman, Marcus Roberts, Nicholas Payton, Mulgrew Miller, Jackie McLean, Charles Lloyd and Dianne Reeves. He has toured extensively all over the globe, and has recorded on over 70 CDs. **Greg Hutchinson**, born in Brooklyn, he quickly became known as a young phenom in the jazz community sharing the stage with the likes of not only Rodney, but Betty Carter, and Ray Brown, while still in his early twenties. He collaborates with: Dianne Reeves, Betty Carter, Wynton Marsalis, John Scofield, Roy Hargrove, Charles Lloyd, Diana Krall, Harry Connick Jr, Joshua Redman, Christian McBride and Maria Schneider as well as many other's.

"Balancing Dreams" is a piano solo album by this amazing pianist from Turin. After the successful albums in trio with Ruben Bellavia and Davide Liberti, he shows all his skill as a piano soloist, in a project full of outstanding musical ideas: new compositions, some standards and a collaboration with the renowned rapper ENSI, mixing jazz and hip hop. Balancing his desires and his dreams, Giachino sets his expressiveness free and leads us into an enthralling space through an uninterrupted, intimate dialogue where his love for jazz, and music in general, reaches its highest aesthetic value.

Class of 1986, is considered one of the most promising talents to appear on the Italian music scene in the past few years. He was awarded by important Italian and European prizes. As a soloist he won the "Premio Internazionale Massimo Urbani 2011", the "Premio Nazionale Chicco Bettinardi 2011", and the "Revelation of the year 2011" JazzUp Channel Red Award. With his trio he was awarded Special Prize as "Best Band" at the "Bucharest International Competition 2014", the "Fara Music Jazz Live 2012" prize (as best soloist and best band), the "Barga Jazz Contest 2012" prize and the "Premio Carrarese Padova Porsche Festival 2011". In 2013, 2012 and 2011 he was among the best 10 Italian pianists according to the "JAZZIT Awards" referendum. His debut album "Introducing Myself", recorded with his trio and featuring the sax player Rosario Giuliani, was included in the 2012 "100 Greatest Jazz Album" selection.
